

Martial Law Materials at University of Michigan, Hatcher Library

The table below lists some of the newsletters, brochures, pamphlets, newspapers, and other publications available at Hatcher Library at the University of Michigan produced by organizations and individuals opposed to Martial Law in the Philippines. Most of the material listed here was written and published by organizations in the United States and the Philippines. This is not a comprehensive guide, and the Library certainly has additional material beyond what is listed here. We encourage scholars to search the catalog, but hope this list can serve as a starting point. Much of this material is housed in the [“Joseph A. Labadie Collection”](#) in the Library’s Special Collections and Archives. Some of the other material can be found on the shelves of Hatcher Library, in the microfilm collections, or off-site storage. Items are listed in alphabetical order by author/organization, dates are provided when known, and a link to the catalog directs researchers to that specific material.
